

**Planning your visit for the sensory-friendly performance of
Junie B. Jones Is Not A Crook**

General Information:

- Face masks are optional
- This performance will have reserved seating. At the time of purchase, you will be able to make your seating selections.
- There will be ushers available in the theatre and lobby if you need assistance. They will be wearing red vests.

Time:

- Lobby doors will open at 10:00 am
- Theatre doors will open at 10:30 am
- The performance will begin at 11:00 am
- Running time of performance: About an hour and twenty-five minutes (including a 20-minute intermission).

Resources:

The following materials for this sensory-friendly performance are available on our website.

- **Pre-visit story:** A visual narrative that may help prepare your child for what to expect at Casa Mañana for the performance.
- **Plot summary:** A description of each act of the story
- **Sensory Map:** An overview of quieter areas you may go to during the performance if your child needs a break.

This performance will have relaxed protocols. This means:

- Children can speak and react during the performance.
- Families will have the option to take breaks from the performance as needed and can return to the performance when ready.

Sensory-friendly performance adjustments:

- There will be no strobe or flashing lights.
- House lights will remain partially on, so the theatre is not completely dark during the performance.
- Sound will be adjusted to lower levels.

A multi-sensory quiet space will be available in the cabaret room:

- Ushers can help direct you to this area.
- This sensory space provides visitors with an area where they can calm down when the theatre experience becomes overstimulating.
- You are also welcome to take breaks in the lobby area.

Food and Beverages:

- Concessions will also be available before the performance and at intermission.

Support Items:

- Audience members are welcome to bring their own manipulatives, comfort objects, earplugs/headphones, and support items to the show.
- While phones and tablets will be allowed in the theatre, photography, and videography **are not** permitted during the performance.
