### **ACT 1**

<b>Summary</b>	<b>Sensory Cues</b>
<p><b><i>The Playground</i></b> Junie B. introduces herself and her two best friends Grace and Lucille. They can't find Lucille and Junie B. makes up a story about why Lucille is late. Junie B. then tells a real story about how her grandfather bought her furry mittens.</p> <p>Junie B. and Grace see that a boy is chasing Lucille! Lucille is mad at Junie B. and Grace because the new boy, Warren, is handsome, and they scared him off. The girls argue about how they all want him to be their boyfriend.</p> <p>The school bell rings, and they are off to class.</p>	<p> Music</p> <p> Warren yelling</p> <p> School bell</p>
<p><b><i>A Kindergarten Classroom</i></b> Junie B. introduces her teacher Mrs. and shows off her new mittens. Junie B. decides she is going to wear her mittens all day, but then Mrs. takes her mittens until recess.</p> <p>Junie B tries to be friends with Lucille again. Junie B. tries to convince her she wouldn't be able to steal her new boyfriend.</p> <p>Junie B and Jim get into a fight. Mrs. makes Junie B. sit back down and complete her schoolwork.</p> <p>Soon it is time for recess and Junie B is excited to get her mittens back.</p>	<p> Music</p> <p> Mrs. yelling</p> <p> The recess bell</p>
<p><b><i>The Playground</i></b> Junie B., Grace, and Lucille play horses. Junie B. breaks up with Ricardo. Junie B. gets too warm and takes off her jacket and mittens. Lucille introduces Grace and Junie B. to Warren. Warren calls Junie B. a nutball.</p> <p>Grace and Lucille both think Warren loves them. They argue about it.</p> <p>Mrs. blows the whistle to say recess is over.</p>	<p> Mrs. blows a whistle</p>

<p>Junie B. can't find her mittens and panics. Junie B. keeps hollering until Mrs. shows up. Mrs. takes her to the principal's office to help her find her mittens because that is where the lost and found is.</p>	
<p><b><i>The Principal's Office</i></b>  Junie B. tells the principal her mittens have been stolen. Junie B.'s mittens were not in the lost and found.</p> <p>On Junie B's way back to her classroom she finds a pen on the ground.</p> <p>Junie B. decides it's "finders keepers" and she is going to keep the pen because it's not stealing.</p>	<p> Music</p> <p> Music</p>

<p><b><i>The Kindergarten Classroom</i></b>  Junie B. keeps her hand in her pocket, so no one notices her pen. Jim is being mean and tells Junie B. why she is a nutball.</p>	<p> Recess bell</p>
<p><b><i>The Playground</i></b>  Junie B. shows Grace that she can sit and be calm because she ate fiber cereal for breakfast instead of sugary cereal.</p> <p>Grace shows Warren her new shoes and Lucille shows Warren her new expensive dress. Junie B. tries to show Warren her new pen and how calm she is, but Warren walks away.</p>	<p> Junie B. scares Grace</p>
<p><b><i>Junie B.'s Bedroom</i></b>  Junie B.'s mother tells her it is time to go to bed. Junie B. talks about how she is sad that she doesn't have her mittens and wonders who the mitten crook is and what they look like.</p> <p>Junie B. dreams:  The mitten crook appears dressed in black stealing one of her stuffed animals. Junie B. and her mother stop the mitten crook and a policeman arrests him.</p> <p>Junie B. wakes up. She has an idea that her grampa could buy her new mittens. Grampa Frank Miller tells Junie B. that he cannot buy her new fuzzy black mittens because the ones he bought her were the last pair.</p>	<p> Junie B. shines a flashlight</p> <p> Music</p>

<p><b><i>The Playground</i></b>  Junie B searches the playground for the mitten crook. A girl in a pink fluffy coat runs by wearing Junie B.'s black fuzzy mittens. The girl says she thought no one wanted them because they were sitting on the ground.</p> <p>Junie B.'s mittens are returned to her. The girl in the pink fluffy coat is upset because she liked the mittens.</p> <p>Junie B. realizes that she can't keep the pen because "finders keepers" isn't the rule.</p>	 School bell rings   Music   Lights shine through the audience
<p><b><i>The Principal's Office</i></b>  Junie B. returns the pen to the lost and found.</p>	
<p><b><i>Junie B.'s Kitchen</i></b>  Junie B. tells her mother they must go to the mall to buy a princess dress and lightning shoes so that Warren will love her.</p> <p>Junie B. wakes up her baby brother so they can go.</p> <p>Mother tells Junie B. they are not going to the mall because you don't make new friends because of your clothes.</p> <p>Junie B. decides to find princess clothes at home.</p>	 Baby crying
<p><b><i>The Playground</i></b>  Junie B arrives at the playground in her princess outfit. All the girls go to talk to Warren about who is the best. Warren yells at them to go away. Junie B. stays and keeps talking to him. Warren starts to cry because he doesn't have friends at this new school. Junie B. makes him feel better by telling jokes and they decide they are both nutballs. They roll on the ground laughing.</p> <p>Ricardo runs over and tells Junie B he found his pen in the lost and found!
